


What's New in 4.1.5


1. Due to the vendor Grantium being purchased by CSDC, the product is now called Grantium and not G3. You will notice different logos, but navigation is basically the same.
2. **IMPORTANT:** For Front Office users who work on projects for more than one applicant there is a new dropdown above the Submissions list for selecting the applicant you want to work on. The Filters and Submission list will only reflect projects for the selected applicant. If you don't see the submission you are looking for, please check this new **Applicant** dropdown!



3. Navigation buttons at the bottom of pages are in different order now with Save and Back being the active when Enter is hit.

4. Submitting a submission automatically brings you back to the submission list.
5. Grantium has checks now to make sure you are only logged in once. If you login a second time, the first session will get the below warning.

6. Other changes you will notice include:
 - Grant application amendments and Quarterly Financial Reports now process independently. There is no longer a need to time amendments to be done before the financial reporting window.
 - For new projects going forward, Grantium will now send reminder notifications when Quarterly Financial Reports are due.
 - Sorted lists will now export to PDF in sorted order
 - Save and Back to list now returns you to the page you were on instead of to page 1.
 - When you sort the Front Office Submission list so that all the un-submitted projects float to the top (your TODO list), the sort is maintained when you open a submission and go Back to the Submission List.
7. Grantium will still send notifications out to ALL users associated with the applicant. We suggest it may be best to configure your email system to filter these notifications so the ones you care about are highlighted for you and others are moved to a location you can ignore. Please work with your email system's technology support team. Things for them to consider in setting up your email filters include:
 - The notification will be sent from EGMS-Admin@state.vt.us
 - The notifications you care about will contain a grant specific phrase in the subject line. For example, use 'CFP' for Consolidated Federal Programs, 'TEE' for Tech Ed Equipment Grant, 'Tobacco' for the Tobacco grant, and 'N or D' for the Neglected or Delinquent grant. Please connect with your program contact to get the specific phrase they will use.
 - To avoid having to change filters annually, do not filter for a specific fiscal year.
 - You will not need to concern yourself with notifications that contain the phrase "Business Office" in the subject line **unless** you will be doing the Quarterly Financial Reports in Grantium.



8. Grantium is primarily tested on the following platforms:
- Internet Explorer 8.0 (Compatibility View turned off) on Windows 7
 - Firefox 12 on Windows 7
 - Chrome 10.0.648 on Windows 7

Additional testing includes the following platforms:

- Firefox 12 on Macintosh OS X 10.6
- Safari 5.1 on Macintosh OS X 10.6

Grantium is also known to work on the following browser versions:

- Internet Explorer 9
- Firefox 5 through 15
- Chrome 10 through 19
